

Public Act 96-0434

On August 13, 2009 Governor Quinn signed into law P.A. 96-00434, which creates two new School Code provisions that require school districts to annually prepare an itemized salary compensation report for every employee holding an administrative certificate and working in that capacity.

The report must be:

- 1) Presented as an information item at a regularly scheduled school board meeting.
- 2) Sent to the Regional Office of Education: and
- 3) Be posted on the school website by October 1.

The average salary compensation for an elementary school district superintendent in Illinois is \$130,000.00.

The average salary compensation for an elementary school principal in Illinois is \$80,000.00.
